SKUAST-K, Weekly activity from December 9-15, 2023

Activity 1 (Multiple activities): SKUAST-K this week conducted seven skill training programs under Entrepreneurship Awareness Programs sponsored by the Union Ministry of MSME at its various Faculties, KVKs and Research stations on a vast range of topics in agriculture and related fields across Kashmir division of J&K UT. Besides entrepreneurs, farmers and youth, a good number of students from the SKUAST-K also participated in these awareness programs conducted by the faculty members and scientists of the university. Each training had 50 participants.

Activity 2: SKUAST-K kick-started on December 12, 2023, its flagship 21-day student orientation-cum-foundation program, IRTIQA 2023, in line with NEP-2020. All the freshers from seven faculties and colleges of the university are participating in the foundation program titled LEED to LIVE - love each other and innovate with the vision to achieve excellence.

Activity 3: SKUAST-K under IRTIQA orientation program organised a Health and Hygiene Mela for the freshers at the Shalimar campus on December 14, 2023. The program was conducted in collaboration with Ujala Sygnus, Super Speciality Hospital, Srinagar, and Safe Hands Dental Health and Awareness Centre. More than 12 specialist doctors were available for consultation. All the fresher students were issued health cards.

Activity 4: The Faculty of Veterinary organised a three-day hands-on training program on 'Applications of Advanced Molecular Techniques in Improvement of Livestock Wealth' under IDP-NAHEP of SKUAST-K December 8-10, 2023. 50 students participated in the training.
