TRAININGS/WORKSHOPS/EXPOSURE VISITS ORGANIZED FOR STUDENTS

Skill development Course-I on "Secondary Agriculture"



The Government of India and Indian Council of Agricultural Research has been emphasizing the importance of skill development vocational training in students of agriculture and allied fields. Therefore, CAAST-NAU organized a 15 days Skill Development Course-I on "Secondary Agriculture" from March 20-April 3, 2019 with objectives to educate participants about the importance, scope and role of secondary agriculture in India and to provide hands on trainings, exposure visits to participants in different aspects of secondary agriculture and to acquaint participants of the recent advances in secondary agriculture. A total of 25 PG students benefitted from the course which included 32 interactive lectures and 2 days of exposure visits.

National training to CAAST Students & SRFs



Eleven CAAST PG students and three SRFs benefitted from training on "Dairy technology for non-dairy technologists" from June 26 to July 1, 2019 at Vidya Dairy. The training included various aspects of milk processing & packaging, hands on experience of milk reception & processing, laboratory practices in dairy plant including cheese making, manufacture of cheddar, mozzarella & processed cheese, knowledge on channa & paneer making, ice cream making, costing of milk and milk products, condensed milk and dried, hands on experience on paneer making, UHT milk & aseptic packaging systems, fermented milk etc. Moreover, students were also educated about trouble shooting of dairy industry. The students also visited Amul Chocolate Plant during the training.

Exports Industries
