EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

1. The Government of India (GOI) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) for funding the National Agricultural Higher Education Project (NAHEP) of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards a consultancy for conducting a study on human resource requirements in agriculture and allied sectors in India under NAHEP. PIU-NAHEP is planning to recruit a specialized agency with relevant qualifications and experiences to perform the study.

The services are to provide a holistic human resource market outlook for Agri and allied Sector in India for next 20 years that could serve as basis for developing strategy and action plans – to address key human resource challenges and create potential employment opportunities. The services include:
 - i. Industry Overview and Human Resource Market Trends.
 - ii. The Potential of Employment needs of Agri and Allied Sector.
 - iii. The Human Resource Requirement Forecast Over a Period of Next 20 Years.
 - iv. Strategic Roadmap and Action Plan.
