# What to do when a fire breaks out



Escape to a safe place



Shout for help and call Fire Service



If trapped, find a safe passage to exit the building



Use the staircase if you are trapped in a high rise building



Grab a blanket (wet it if possible), wrap your body around it and crawl out



If doors are on fire, wet some clothes and place them under the door - it will stop smoke from entering the room



Do not run if your body catches on fire, Stop, drop and roll to put out the fire



Avoid using remedies such as toothpaste to treat burns on body



wash with tap water for 10 minutes



Seek medical help

## Laboratory Dress



## Housekeeping



Keep the laboratory organized and uncluttered for fast evacuation

## Chemical Spill

- Wear shoes covered from all sides while cleaning chemical spills
- Do not sweep spilled chemicals with a broom
- Spray agents that solidify chemical spills or neutralize them
- Do not dump cloth soaked in spilled chemicals in a water bin.
- Ventilate the room

## Labelling Chemicals



Always store chemicals in a rack and place a caution sign



Do not use the chemicals from unlabelled containers



Never store at locations where they can be knocked over

## Harmful Vapours

Ventilate the room. Open all door and windows

Use Respirator



Mask



Use fume hood



Open all the windows to let the vapours out



Switch on the exhaust fans

## Eye wash



Let water go directly into the eyes. Keep your hands free to hold your eyes open. Rinse eyeballs and interior of the eyes gently for about 15 minutes

## Waste Containers



Segregate and dispose hazardous and non-hazardous waste in separate bins and bags
